MONT CHARLES-ÉDOUARD-VÉZINA TRAIL




HIKING DESCRIPTION

Starting at the John registration centre the trail heads to the east, with the omnipresence of the Matane River for the first three kilometers. It then joins Route 1 and continues on the other side with a moderate climb in a mature mixed forest of cedar, pine, yellow and white birch and red maple. After climbing a steep slope for 400 meters the hiker will be rewarded with a beautiful view over the Matane River valley. It is the top of the Charles-Édouard-Vézina with an altitude of 390 meters and the western entrance of the Chic-Chocs range. The mount was named in memory of the founder of the Society of History and Genealogy of Matane.

Option 1: Heading east from the John registration centre you can enjoy with your family a pleasant walk along the Matane River. The trail reaches Route 1, 3.5 km further. From there on you can return to the John registration centre using Route 1 (2.6 km) or the trail again (3.5 km). Parking available at the John registration center.

Option 2: You can park 2.6 km east of John registration centre in Des Pins parking lot. You can hike from there up Mount Charles-Édouard-Vézina a loop is possible at the top and go back down, totalizing 4.6 km.

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
